Prior to that meeting, at 6:15 pm, Phillip Murray, Ephraim City Recreation Director, would like to meet with any parents who coached baseball during 2015.

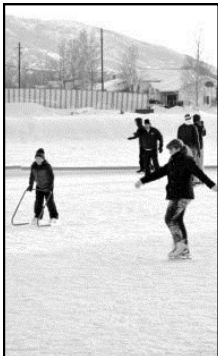
The purpose of this meeting is to determine
