Ephraim City Recreation Field Workers and Umpires Wanted



The Recreation Department is seeking Field Workers for the Baseball Complex. Applicants must be 16 years old, have a valid driver license and be able to lift 50 lbs or more. Applicants must also have a good work attitude and work ethic. The position has varying hours during the day,

evenings and Saturdays. Responsibilities include the following: Prep and field cleanup, clean restrooms, sweep dugouts, weed fence lines, and other duties as assigned. Must be able to be on call in case of rain. Some tournament work runs into the late evening or early morning. Work could start as early as

5:00 a.m. during a tournament weekend.

Umpires for Baseball or Softball games: if you are 15 or older, we need individuals who are willing to umpire behind the plate and on the bases. This job runs evenings, Monday thru Thursday, starting at 4:30 p.m. to as late as 11:00 p.m. or later and could

involve some weekends. During the month of July we will have accelerated softball and baseball teams playing Monday thru Friday evenings. Games will start May 2, 2016 and run until the first part of August.

Applications for either position may be obtained at the City offices.
