

#### WATER RIGHTS PURCHASED For EPHRAIM CITY

The additional water should provide for roughly 350 new residential unils in our Cily.

For the last year, Ephraim City has been working to secure additional water rights in an effort to have added water to our City water system.

The State Engineer has approved the change application allowing the City to use the water rights as culinary water and the transaction should close this

week. The additional water should provide for roughly 350 new residential units in our City.

Now that we have the water rights, we will be seeking another source for the water, preferably a well close to the new water tank built last year, so the water can flow through the City's hydroelectric plant and contribute to our electric generation, as well as provide needed water for future growth.
